


## Tour Host Marge Fenelon

## ITINERARY

### DAY 1-Mon, January 11: Depart USA

- ✠ Our pilgrimage begins as we leave home connecting to our overnight flight to **Israel**.
- ✠ Enjoy dinner and breakfast in-flight

### DAY 2- Tuesday, January 12: Joppa / Netanya

- ✠ Arrive at Israel's modern Ben Gurion Airport. Meet our Catholic professional licensed guide & motor coach driver.
- ✠ Continue to **Joppa, the oldest Sea Port** and offer Mass at St. Peter's Church. (Jonah 1:3-17 / Acts 10:5; 9:36-42)
- ✠ Continue to our hotel in Netanya by the **Mediterranean Sea**. Time at leisure before having dinner together. (Breakfast snack on flight with dinner at our hotel)

### DAY 3- Wednesday, January 13: Caesarea / Galilee

- ✠ Visit **Caesarea Maritime**, impressive ruins of a Roman city built by Herod. Paul was a prisoner here & gentile Cornelius, was baptized. (Acts 10)
- ✠ Continue to **Nazareth**, site of the Annunciation (Luke 1:26-38) and Jesus' preaching (Luke 4:15-30). Celebrate Mass.
- ✠ In taxis ascend **Mt. Tabor**, site of the Transfiguration (Mt. 17:1-9)
- ✠ Renew wedding vows at **Cana** (John 2: 1-11). Check into our Guest House on Mount of Beatitudes and have dinner.



### DAY 4-Thursday, January 14: The Sea of Galilee:

- ✠ Offer Mass at the **Mount of Beatitudes** (Mt. 5:1-12 Sermon on the Mount); then visit **Tabgha** of multiplication of loaves and fish (Mark 6:30-46) and The Sanctuary of the **Primacy of Peter** (John 21)
- ✠ Visit **Capernaum**, center of Jesus' ministry (Mathew 4:13) After **boat ride**, return to Guesthouse for dinner.

### DAY 5- Friday, January 15: The Galilee / Jerusalem

- ✠ Begin our journey visiting ancient **Magdala**; celebrate Mass (Luke 8:1-2). Pope Francis blessed the Tabernacle.
  - ✠ Continue to **Jerusalem** stopping at **Kasar el Yehud** to renew our baptismal promises in the Jordan River (Mt. 3:16-17) and then to **Jericho**, the Tel and viewpoint to **Mount of Temptation** (Mark 1:13). See the **Inn of the Good Samaritan**; then arrive in Jerusalem and check into our hotel Guesthouse and have dinner.
- Itinerary continued on other side.*

#### **DAY 6— Saturday, January 16: Bethlehem / Qumran**

☩ Today we visit the birthplace of Jesus in **Bethlehem** in the Church of the Nativity and see **Shepherd's Field**. (Lk. 2:1-7) Visit a Christian Olive Wood Shop. Drive through the Judean Desert to **Qumran** to view the caves where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** early manuscripts of the Bible were discovered. Have the opportunity for swimming in the **Dead Sea**, the lowest place on earth. Return to Jerusalem.

#### **DAY 7— Sunday, January 17: Jerusalem**

☩ Drive to the **Mount of Olives** to see a spectacular view of the Temple Mount and Church of Pater Noster and of the Resurrection. Walk down the Palm Sunday road past Dominus Flevit to the **Garden of Gethsemane** (Mt. 26:36-46). Celebrate Mass.

☩ Visit the **Church of St. Ann**, with the traditional birthplace of Mary. Nearby is **Pool of Bethesda site of one of Jesus' miracles**. (Jn. 5:1-17) Then stop to pray at the **Western Wall**, Judaism's most holy site. Visit **Mount Zion**, the **Upper Room** and site of Pentecost. (Mt. 26:25-35; Lk. 22 14-38) and the **Church of the Dormition Abbey**.

#### **DAY 8— Monday, January 18: Jerusalem**

☩ This morning visit the **Shrine of the Book** housing the ancient manuscripts of the Bible found hidden in the caves at Qumran in 1948. Outside walk around an enormous **Model of the City of Jerusalem and the Temple** during the time of Jesus.

☩ Opportunity to enter the cistern where Jesus was held prisoner in Caiaphas' house now in the **Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu** (The Cock's Crow). (Cf. Mark 14) Offer Mass.

#### **DAY 9— Tuesday, January 19: Jerusalem**

☩ Visit the museum of **Yad Vashem** describing the events of the Holocaust. Outside there are commemorative trees planted for the many Christians who aided the Jews during the time of injustice and terror. Thousands of Catholic priests were put into the concentration camps. Half of them died of starvation and other torture.

☩ For the holy sacrifice of the Mass, we will drive to the hill country to **Ein Karem**, the birthplace of John the Baptist and the site of the **Visitation of Mary** to her cousin Elizabeth.

#### **DAY 10— Wednesday, January 20: Jerusalem**

☩ Have some free time in the morning for packing or to revisit a sacred site or to purchase special mementos in order to share your experience with others. Then check out of the hotel.

☩ We will make the **Stations of the Cross** on our way to **Calvary** which is now inside the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**. Touch the rock at the holy site and pray at the unction stone where they lay the Lord's body. Opportunity to enter the empty **Tomb of Jesus** and then nearby offer holy Mass of the Resurrection with prayers for peace and thanksgiving. Gather for a farewell dinner before going to the airport for the overnight return flight.



#### **DAY 11— Thursday, January 12: Return to USA**

☩ Meal and snack on our overseas connecting flight.

**\* NON-REFUNDABLE on September 10, 2015**

The price is based on per person double occupancy. A single supplement of \$600 is available on a limited basis. Single rooms although cost a supplement they are usually smaller. Triple rooms may have two small beds and a pullout sofa. Travel Insurance is required. Money from the first deposit will go toward the insurance for person's up to age 69. Insurance is calculated by age and cost of the trip. Persons above age 69 will have to pay the additional cost in their age category. Speaker's Travel Lion and the Lamb Journeys of West Lafayette, Indiana (collectively, "Travel Agents") serve only as agents of the airline motor coach, and other vendors involved in the tours offered by Travel Agents. Neither the Travel Agents, nor their respective officers and employees, have any responsibility for any acts or omissions (negligent, intentional or otherwise) of any airline, bus company, sightseeing or guide service, hotel, or any other vendor or provider of services involved in the Pilgrimage to the Holy Land, which result in delays, missed carrier connections, accidents or other events resulting in monetary loss, personal injury to or death of any person, or damage to any real or personal property. The above listed parties are not responsible for loss, theft or damage to the personal belongings of any participant, including passports and travel documents. I understand that the price could change if the number of participants are fewer than 30 and if additional taxes are put on airlines, hotels, and other services by the countries involved. I am aware that I am responsible for attaining a passport and having this document in my possession during the tour. Although itineraries are not changed randomly, we reserve the right to make changes after reservation, when the change is in the best interest of our participants, or when the situations beyond the control of the above listed agencies make these changes necessary. The tour cost could increase if fewer than 30. **Travel insurance premium is based on age and cost of the trip. It will be collected at the time of deposit for this pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Insurance is in addition to the cost of the pilgrimage and will be added to total price.**

**Not Included:** Any increase in fuel surcharge or additional taxes by airline before ticketing, gratuities to guides & bus drivers, donations for Masses, meals not listed, drinks at meals, items of a personal nature such as passports.
